GREEN CITIES CHALLENGE PLANNING

Chairperson Woulfe-Beile reported the Village attended the start-up training for Green Cities Challenge in St. Louis with Clerk Whisler and herself. Chairman Woulfe-Beile reported that Madison County has taken care of the registration fee for the Village.

SHRED-IT AND E-WASTE DAY

Clerk Whisler reported that she is working on obtaining dates for the 2018 Shred-It Day of May 19 at a cost of \$500 and E-Waste in June with Ultimate Electronic Recycling, Inc. of Carlinville, Illinois at no charge for 2 hours. The Village will have to place restrictions on the Shred-it for residents only and no businesses and no cardboard.

WASTE HAULERS RECYCLING

Chairman Woulfe-Beile reported that the Village has received the 2017 reports from the WasteHaulers. The Committee will continue reviewing the reports as they are reported. Chairman Woulfe-Beile reported that individual recycling containers are working very well. The Committee suggested educating the community on proper recycling. The Committee also suggested using the theme Reduce, Reuse and Recycle for educational format.

LCCC SPRING EARTH DAY – APRIL 18, 2018

Chairman Woulfe-Beile on April 18, 2018, LCCC Spring Earth Day between the hours of 10:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. The committee will participate in the event. The Committee discussed the format for the table. Committee members will
