Re: 2019 Micro-Surfacing Project

Dear Resident:

Please be advised that your subdivision has been included in this year's micro-surfacing program.

What is micro-surfacing?

Micro-surface is a surface treatment that is typically applied to asphalt pavement to help seal its surface and preserve its condition. The micro-surface application is applied to the entire street surface between the curbs and helps provide a new wearing surface for the roadway.

Micro-surfacing is not the same as pavement resurfacing. Rather, micro-surfacing is a seal coat that will help preserve the relatively good condition of your street.

Street Closure and Parking Restrictions

The micro-surfacing application can be installed rather quickly with a short setting time. However, traffic cannot use the new surface until it cures, and the following will be necessary on the scheduled day of the work:

- The street will be closed to traffic beginning as early as 7:00 a.m.
- Emergency vehicles will have access at all times, if needed.
- Parking will not be allowed on either side of any street in the subdivision.
- ***All streets will be open to traffic by 5:00 p.m. each day***, except the ends of cul-de-sacs, which may remain closed to vehicles overnight to allow the material to cure properly.
- Work crews will remove cones and barricades when the road re-opens.

Tentatively, the micro-surfacing will take place during the week of September 23, 2019. We understand that this will be an inconvenience. Construction nearly always is. However, we are trying to limit that inconvenience as much as possible. Please look for posted no parking signs and notifications of street closures, and plan accordingly.
