



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

DEER TRAIL STORMWATER REPAIR PROJECT VILLAGE OF GODFREY, ILLINOIS

PROPOSALS DUE: 3:00 PM, WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 24, 2025

The Village of Godfrey (Village) seeks proposals to replace a deteriorated stormwater pipe within the Piasa Hills Subdivision in the Village of Godfrey, IL.

Project Description

The 24" corrugated metal pipe (CMP) that runs between 5908 and 5906 Deer Trail is failing and has caused sinkholes to form in the adjacent yards. The Village wishes to replace the existing CMP with a 24" High-Density Polyethylene (HDPE) pipe with a smooth interior. All work regarding the installation of storm sewer pipe shall be according to the Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction, latest edition.

All work shall be accomplished within the confines of the existing easements. If the contractor requires additional room to complete the work, the contractor shall coordinate with the respective property owners. Any damage, or subsequent restoration thereof, that takes place outside of the existing easements will be the sole responsibility of the contractor.

It is believed that a water service line is present under the existing CMP. The contractor shall be responsible for contacting J.U.L.I.E. prior to any work to verify its location and the location of any other utilities in the work area. Coordination with utilities on any adjustments is considered incidental to the project and should be included in the price of the proposal.

This is a prevailing wage project. Certified payrolls and final lien waivers will be required prior to issuance of final payment.

Project Schedule

Work for this project is expected to begin as soon as possible and is estimated to require no more than five (5) working days to complete. The contractor will be issued a notice to proceed following the submission of a Certificate of Insurance showing the Village of Godfrey as an additional insured.

The contractor is encouraged to perform the work when rain is not forecast for several days in order to minimize any erosion. Any track out onto the street shall be cleaned at the end of each workday.

Submission Information

Proposals will be accepted no later than 3:00 pm on Wednesday, September 24, 2025. Proposals will not be publicly opened. A tabulation of the proposals will be issued by email as soon as possible thereafter. Proposals shall be a lump sum and shall be submitted on company letterhead. The Lump Sum Proposal shall consist of the following items, but not limited to: traffic control; mobilization;

layout; excavation, hauling, and disposal of existing corrugated metal pipe as well as any waste and excess material; furnishing and installing a temporary fence; removal and replacement of any chain-link fence required to complete the work; furnishing and installing bedding material for pipe and riprap; installing 24" HDPE pipe (approx. 133 linear feet) furnished and delivered to the site by the Village; furnishing and installing backfill material; furnishing and installing geotextile fabric and RR4 riprap (approx. 10 tons) at the pipe outlets; modification of the curb inlet structure to remove the CMP pipe and provide an opening for the HDPE pipe; sealing the opening in the wall of the curb inlet structure following pipe installation; grading; seed and straw; and final cleanup. Submissions may be made by mail, hand delivery, or e-mail. E-mail submissions are preferred.

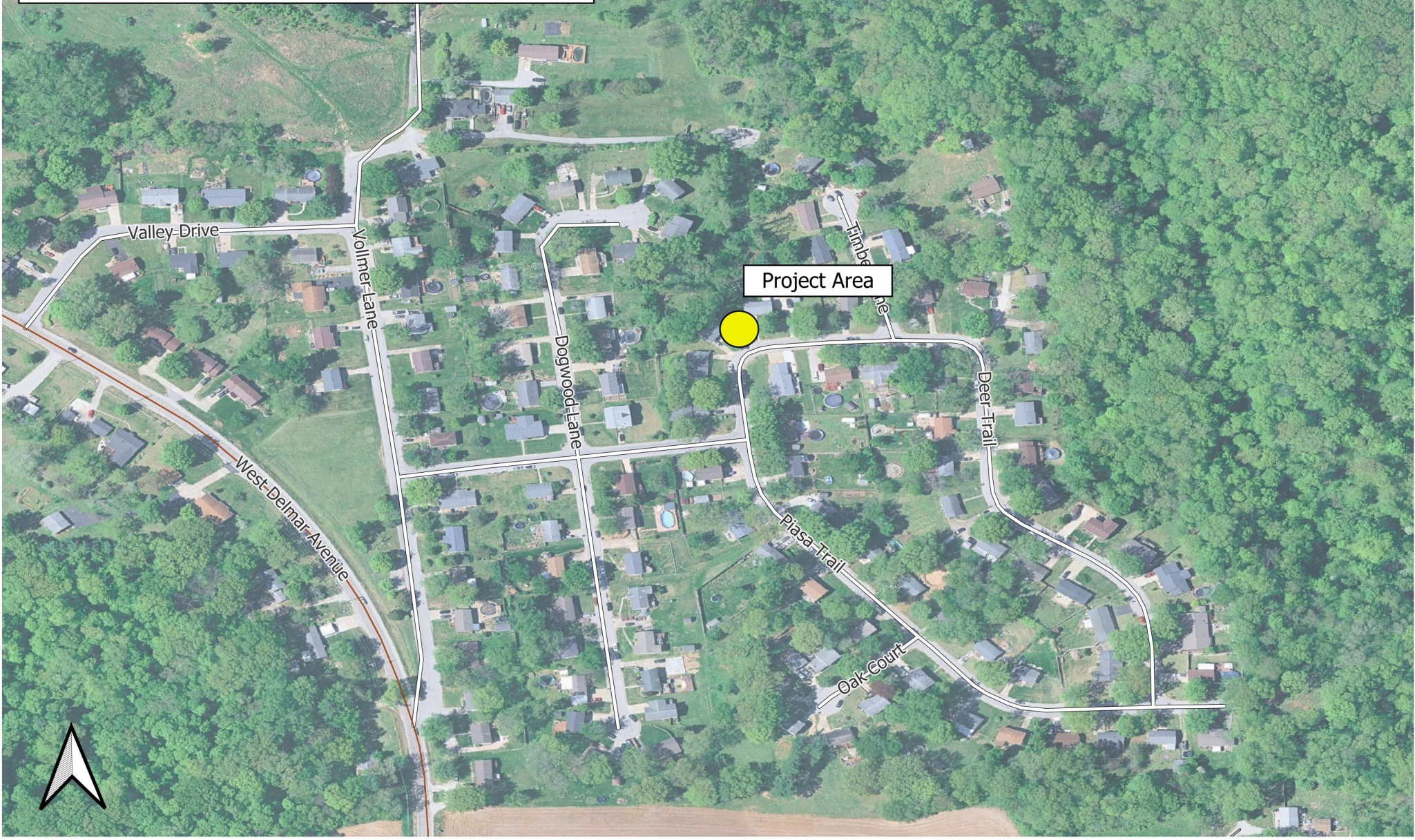

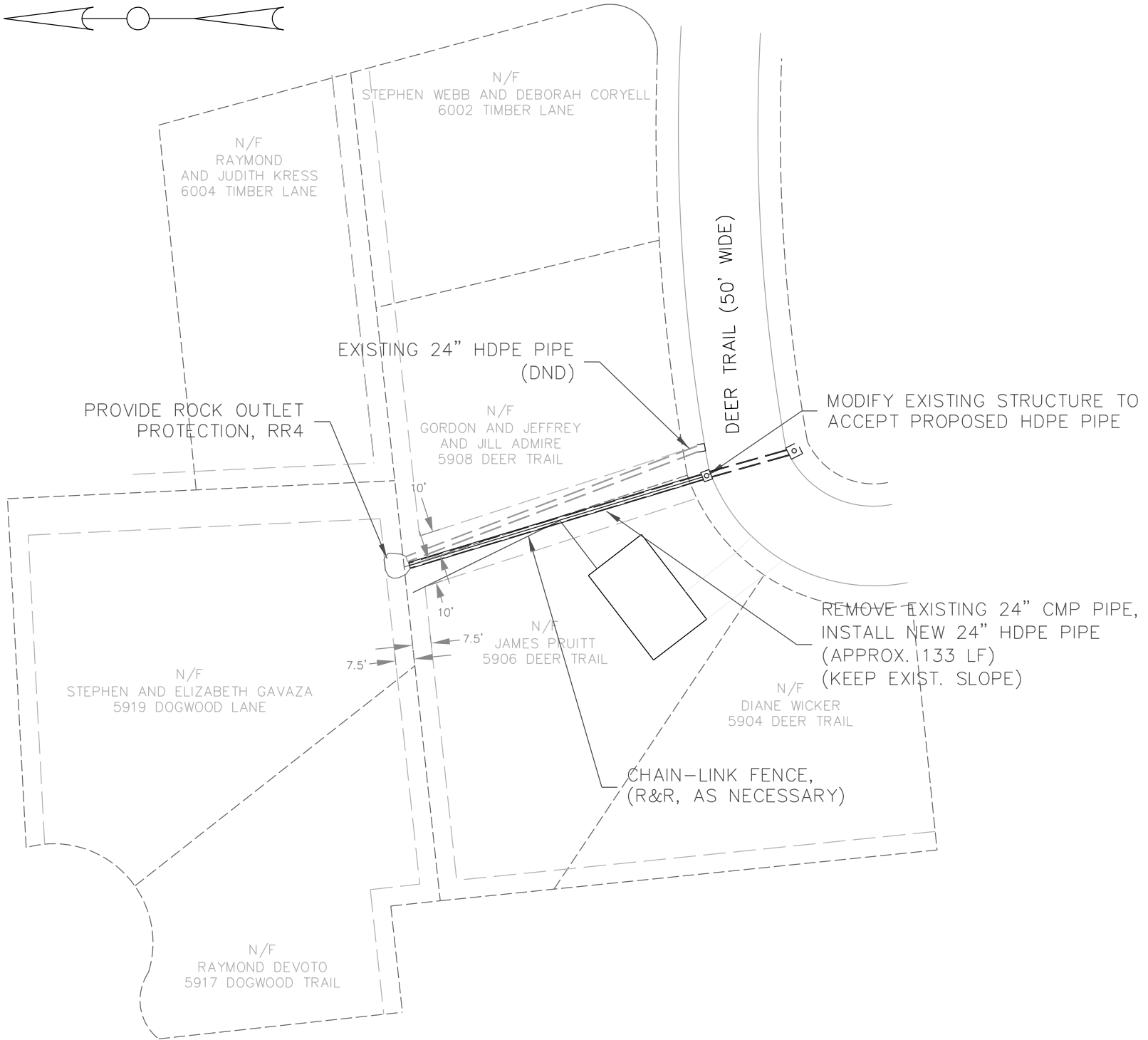
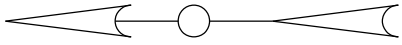

3. The Contractor and its subcontractors have Workers' Compensation Insurance that covers its employees working on the Project and such insurance meets or exceeds the requirements established by law. A Certificate of Insurance (COI) shall be submitted to the Village for approval prior to beginning any work.

Prior to making any payments to the Contractor, the Village shall receive a Certified Payroll for the period billed by the Contractor.

6. The Contractor and its subcontractors are in compliance with federal law requiring an accredited apprenticeship program, if applicable.

7. The Contractor and its subcontractors are enrolled and participate in a federal work authorization program with respect to employees working in connection with the contracted services.
