



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS

CAMELLIA PLACE PIPE REPAIR

VILLAGE OF GODFREY, ILLINOIS

PROPOSALS DUE: 9:00 AM, WEDNESDAY, JULY 22, 2026

The Village of Godfrey (Village) seeks proposals from qualified contractors to excavate and remove a blockage in a stormwater pipe, to install a manhole at a buried junction, to perform an inspection on the remaining pipe, and to replace other sections of pipe determined to need replacement during the inspection.

Project Description

A recent camera inspection of the stormwater pipe that runs between 4619 and 4617 Camellia Place identified a large blockage approximately 85 feet from the curb inlet. The scope of the subject project consists of:

- The excavation of an existing 27" Corrugated Metal Pipe (CMP) at an estimated depth of 8.5' to remove the blockage that cannot be removed by other means. Due to the proximity of the excavation to existing homes and depth of excavation, a trench box or another acceptable means of temporary shoring will be required.
- The excavation of an existing 27" CMP at an additional location where a sinkhole has formed in the rear of 4619 Camellia Place above a pipe that receives stormwater runoff from the north will also require repair.
- The replacement of a buried tee junction with a set-over manhole for future access.
- The remaining pipe will need to be inspected for damage and/or additional blockages.
- If any additional issues are found during the inspection, the contractor shall address those issues as directed by the engineer.

This is a prevailing wage project. Certified payrolls and final lien waivers will be required prior to issuance of final payment.

Project Schedule

Work for this project is expected to begin within ten (10) calendar days of the Notice to Proceed and is expected to require no more than five (5) working days to complete. Manufacturing lead time shall not be counted as a working day. The contractor will be issued a notice to proceed following the submission of a Certificate of Insurance showing the Village of Godfrey as an additional insured. It shall be assumed that the submission of a proposal indicates that the Contractor is familiar with the site, materials, and equipment necessary to perform the work.

Submission Information

Proposals will be accepted no later than 9:00 am on Wednesday, July 22, 2026. Proposals will not be publicly opened. A tabulation of the proposals will be issued by email as soon as possible thereafter. Proposals shall be submitted on the attached Proposal Form or on company letterhead in a similar format. The Proposal shall consist of the following items, but not limited to: traffic control; mobilization; removal and replacement of up to 10 linear feet of pipe at 2 or more locations; hauling and disposal of all unsuitable materials, excavation of a buried tee junction of unknown type and replacement of the junction with a manhole; inspection of the remaining pipes located east of the blockage and replacement of any additional areas as directed by the engineer; restoration and final cleanup. Proposal submissions may be made by mail, hand delivery, or e-mail. E-mail submissions are preferred.

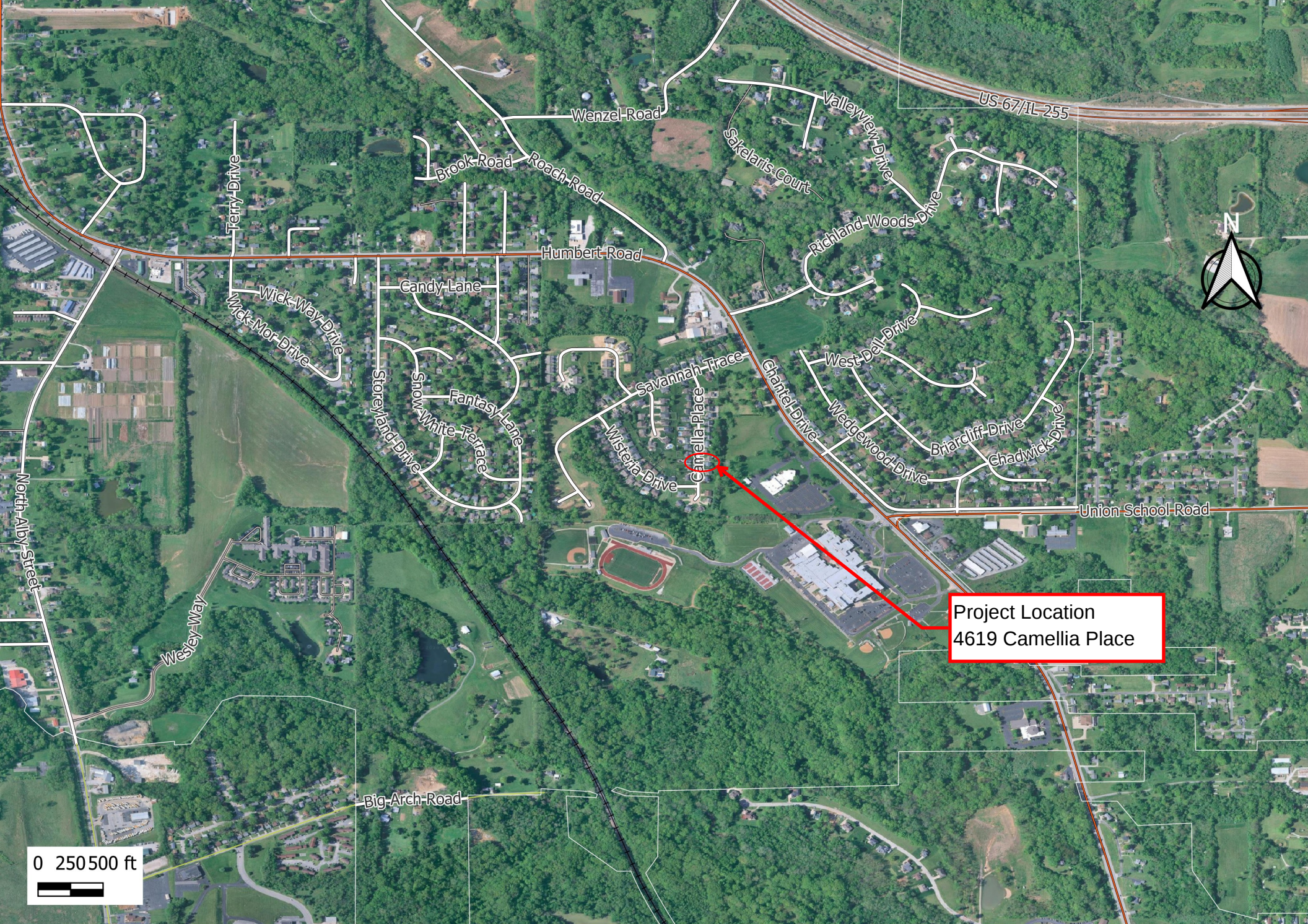

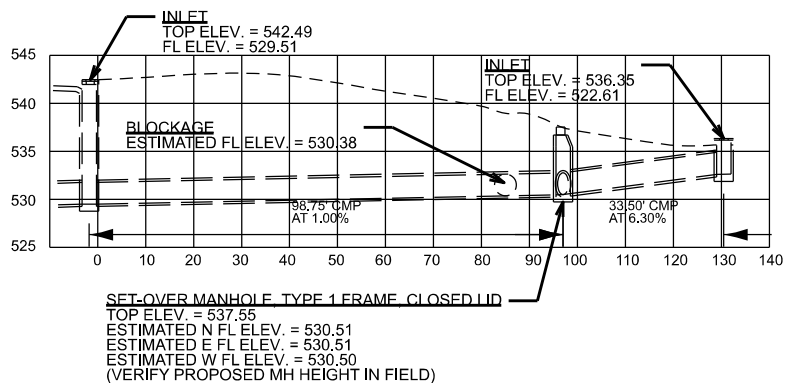
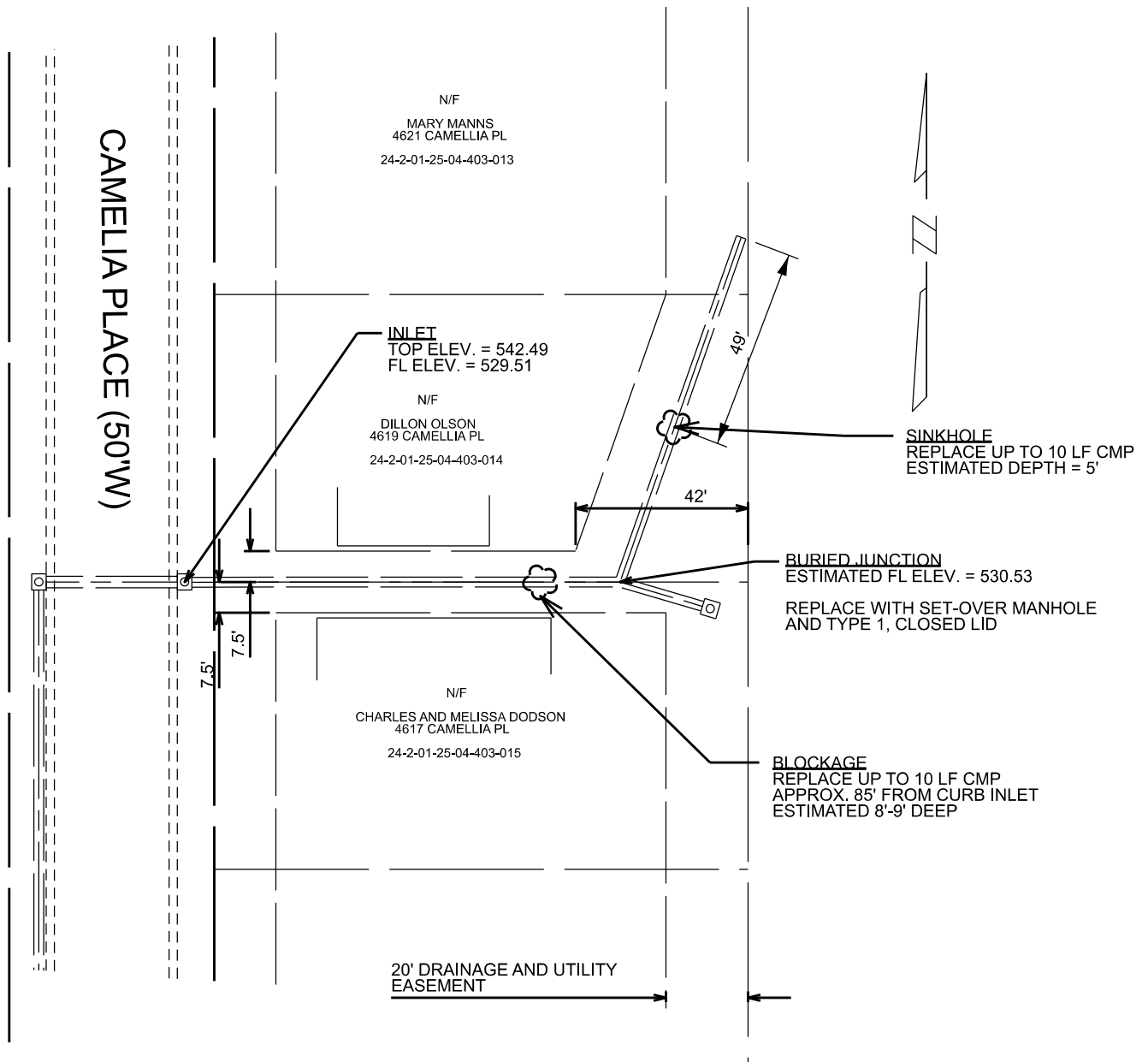

6. The Contractor and its subcontractors are in compliance with federal law requiring an accredited apprenticeship program, if applicable.

7. The Contractor and its subcontractors are enrolled and participate in a federal work authorization program with respect to employees working in connection with the contracted services.
